We can make a difference TOGETHER!



Lakshmi Silva, 2024 Scholarship Winner

Following are excerpts from her essay which very adequately met the criteria set out by our board:

Growing up in a Sinhala, Catholic household, my family, especially my mother, instilled in me a deep respect for the value of life. My mother, a strong and devoted woman, played a central role in shaping my beliefs, alongside the teachings of our Catholic church and my schooling in a Catholic background.

When I was a young adult, my mother shared an emotional memory of hers with me. When my mother became pregnant with me at the age of 38, she faced criticism from a neighbour who suggested she consider abortion due to the challenges of raising four children while my dad, a Warrant Officer in the Air Force, was often away. This made my mother feel utterly sad. At that moment, my father's reassurance of their ability to nurture us as parents underscored the value my parents placed on every life, no matter the circumstances. This memory, shared with me by my mother, not only illuminated the strength of their bond but also reinforced the importance of cherishing and protecting every life.


Unfortunately, my father passed away when I was just ten, leaving my mother to single-handedly care for us. Despite the hardships, her strength and unwavering commitment to us left a lasting impression on me. My mother, with her sacrificial love, became my ultimate role model. It was her teachings, her unwavering belief in the value of every life, that guided me towards embracing a pro-life stance.

In conclusion, I remain steadfast in my commitment to positively impacting the lives of those around me. I am eager to continue volunteering at the Pro-Life Society and contributing to meaningful causes, as I firmly believe that through acts of service and compassion, we can spread God's love and mercy to all.

Dr. Ming Wang, World Renowned and Pro-life



His beginnings were in Communist China, in hunger, poverty and despair, but his parents set an amazing example of hope in the middle of darkness. After surmounting impossible odds, his immigration to the US led him to graduate from Harvard Medical School with honours, to attain a further medical degree elsewhere and to become a laser eye surgeon.

Dr. Wang allowed his atheistic beliefs to be challenged by his friendship with a professor who posed to him valid questions about the evidence for 'intelligent design' (that is, a universe created by God, not by chance). He came to see that science, which often opposes planned creation in favour of random evolution, and faith, can co-exist as they offer a compatible whole. For him, this meant that science provided the 'tools' to concretely develop ideas, but that faith in God provided the purpose for doing so.

Focusing upon this balance, he has used his outstanding skills to discover and patent bio-technological inventions to restore sight, including creating an amniotic membrane contact lens which heals the surface of the eye free of scarring. His research, along with others', led to investigating the manner in which preborn babies naturally heal without scarring. Because of his pro-life stance, he would not experiment on aborted fetal tissue, eventually discovering that the placenta and amniotic membrane held the answer. This operation alone has helped millions of patients.

He saw the triumph of his firm adherence to the sanctity of life as proof that

science and faith can complement one another.

Part way through one of his most difficult surgeries, in which the young patient had no vision in her one eye and only one percent in the other, he lost hope in his ability to proceed; instead, he chose to put his faith in God and felt a calmness which allowed him to regain his confidence. The dramatic answer to his prayer came when the girl indicated correctly how many fingers the Dr. was holding up -- her 'good' eye had improved to 20% vision!

His Wang Foundation for Sight Restoration performs surgeries pro bono in many countries around the world.

Newly-released, the biographical film 'Sight' details the true account of his assistance to a young orphan and the resultant transformation of the Dr.'s life, releasing him from the pain of his past into the freedom of fully giving to others.
